## Future Plans

The next stage of our redevelopment includes the restoration of our old Woollen Mill, formerly the Woollen Spinning and Carding Departments. We shall be designing this as a fully integrated Sustainable Building project. These 2 Buildings were built in the 1840s from locally quarried stone. During the 2<sup>nd</sup> World War the buildings were reinforced with substantial steel formwork to allow for heavier machines. This will provide added character to this exciting development.

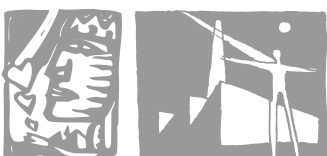

### Renewable Energy

Brooke's Mill is endeavouring to restore its 2 water turbines and the adjoining Mill Race. This could provide 100 KW of electricity, which would provide up to 30% of the power required by the site. Although the company is looking at other renewable energy sources, it is considered that waterpower will have the greatest future impact in reducing our carbon footprint.

### Woodland Management

Brooke's Mill will be operating a woodland management scheme on 60 acres of surrounding woodland. This will include encouraging natural regrowth and selective planting of Beech and Oak, which form the majority of the tree species.
